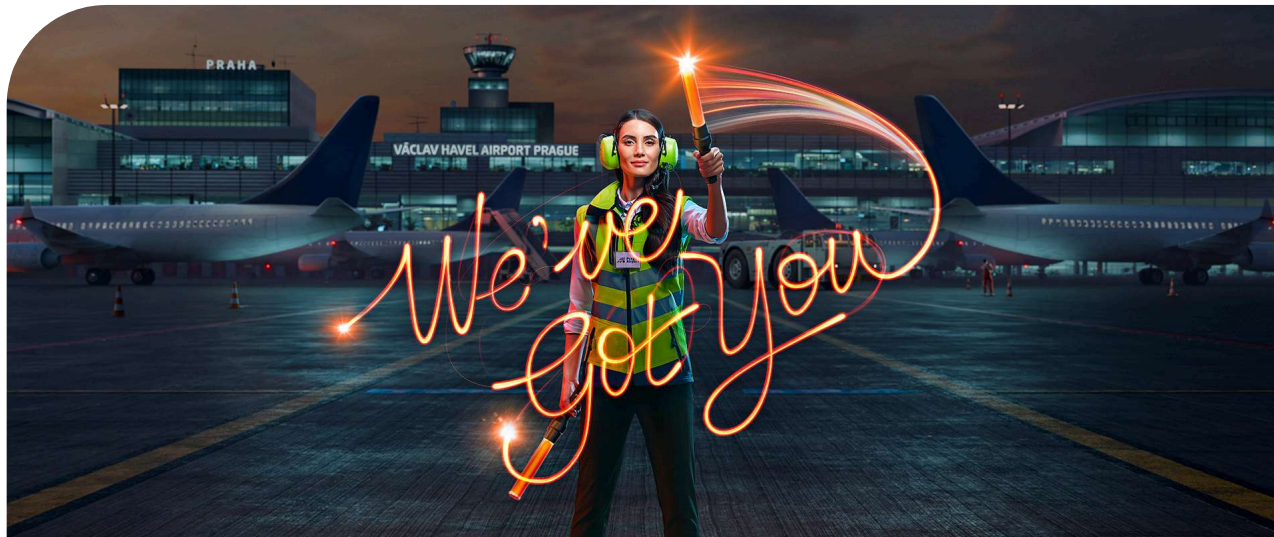

## Fly from Prague to Malta Year-Round



We would like to announce the extension of the KM Malta Airlines service to Malta to year-round operations. During the summer season, flights will continue to be offered three times a week (on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays), while during the winter season the frequency will be adjusted to two flights a week (on Tuesdays, Saturdays).



## Korean Air's Largest Dreamliner



With the start of the summer season, Korean Air will operate a Boeing 787-10 Dreamliner with a capacity of 325 seats on its route from Prague to Seoul. Passengers can look forward to new Business and Economy classes. At the same time, cargo capacity will increase by 15%.

Croatia Airlines has announced its plans to resume direct flights between Zagreb and Prague. The new route will be operated by a modern Airbus A220-300 aircraft with a capacity of 149 seats, which will be available to passengers three times a week. The first flight is planned on 2 July 2025. At the same time, the company will increase capacity on the existing route between Prague and popular Croatian destination Dubrovnik.
