Twenty Years in the European Union



On the anniversary of Czechia's accession to the EU, Prague Airport was visited by Lufthansa's Airbus A320 in the "Yes to Europe" livery. The blue and white Airbus of D-AIUC registration mark was greeted with a water salute ceremony.



New Direct Connection to the Azores



On 26 April, a direct connection from Prague Airport to Ponta Delgada was launched. The new regular route will be operated twice a week, on Tuesdays and Fridays, using Boeing 737-800 with a capacity of 189 seats.

15 Years of Prague – New York Route with Delta Air Lines

After the winter break, Delta Air Lines resumed operation of its regular connection from Prague to New York, which it will service on a daily basis until 6 October 2024. Flights to John F. Kennedy International Airport will be operated by Boeing 767-300ER aircraft for 217 passengers, with the cabin configuration of 181 seats in Economy Class and 36 seats in Business Class. Delta Air Lines has been providing its regular flights between Prague and the American metropolis regularly since 19 June 2009. The route operation was disrupted only in 2020 and 2021 due to the Covid-19 pandemic.



Prague Airport and Korean Air Celebrate Two Decades of Seoul Connection

One of the oldest and most important long-haul routes at Václav Havel Airport Prague celebrated its 20th anniversary on 15 May. Between 2004 and 2024, over 1.5 million passengers used the connection between Prague and Seoul. Korean Air is now using a Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner to operate the route. On the day of the anniversary, the aircraft was welcomed by the airport firefighters with a water salute in Prague, and there was also a rich accompanying program at the gate.

Nearly 1.4 million passengers and over 13,100 flights; these are the numbers which best describe the twentieth anniversary of TAP Air Portugal's route between Prague and Lisbon. During the celebrations at Václav Havel Airport Prague, a unique Airbus A321neo in a special retro livery arrived in Prague. The airport firefighters welcomed it with a traditional water salute and there was also an accompanying program at the gate.
