Prague Airport Cargo Point



Prague Airport has signed a memorandum on the development of cargo air transport together with 12 other companies which joined the Prague Airport Cargo Point statement. The new platform is to help boost the competitiveness and development of cargo air transport at Václav Havel Airport Prague. The main goal is to make Prague Airport more attractive, especially for long-haul carriers. Prague Airport Cargo Point is supposed to grow as further subjects joins in.



Korean Air Dreamliner four times per week

Since the beginning of summer schedule, Korean Air increased frequency to four flights per week – Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday. All flights are operated by Boeing 787 Dreamliner. Cargo to Tbilisi on Georgian Wings



As of 7th May, Georgian Wings open regular passenger flight to Tbilisi (TBS). On Tuesdays and Saturdays, you will have a chance to book cargo on Boeing 737, not just to Georgia but also to connecting destinations in the region.

Qanot Sharq – Your Eastward Wing



„Eastward Wing“ – Qanot Sharq in uzbek will land in Prague for the first time 30th May. This direct connection between Prague and Tashkent (TAS) will initially fly one weekly flight, every Thursday on Airbus A320.



FlyOne – direct flight to Moldova



Chisinau (RMO) is another destination that has been missing in our list of connections. In 17th June, this absence will be over. FlyOne starts regular flight connecting Czech Republic with Moldova twice per week with their Airbus A320.



Hainan Airlines are back in Prague



We are happy to welcome Hainan Airlines regular passenger flight connecting Prague with Beijing. The flight will start 24th June and will fly three times per week – Monday, Wednesday, Friday – by Airbus 330-200. This flight will help to cover increasing demand for import and export between China and Czechia.
